

**2007 (Fall) NEVADA STATE SHORT COURSE**  
**SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

NOVEMBER 9-12, 2007

Hosted by

THE CARSON TIGERSHARKS

**SANCTION:** Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. **1597J**

**LOCATION:** Carson Aquatic Facility, 841 N. Roop St. Carson City, NV. From Business Hwy. 395 go two traffic lights East on Hwy. 50 (E. Williams St.). Turn right on Roop St. and go one block south. Turn left behind the Carson City Community Center. From Reno on Hwy. 395 take exit 39. Turn right and travel West for .9 mile. Turn left into Mills Park and the Carson City Community Center. Additional parking is available at the Bank of America at the north- west corner of Roop St. and Hwy. 50 (E. Williams St.).

**COURSE:** 50 meter X 25 yard indoor heated pool. 8 short course lanes for competition and 8 short course lanes for warm-up and warm-down. Colorado Timing System with Touch Pads and scoreboard.

**TIME:** **FRIDAY TIMED FINALS:** begins at 4:00 p.m. with warm-ups from 2:30-3:45 p.m.  
**SAT, SUN, & MON PRELIMS (11 & OVER):** begin at 8:30 a.m., with warm-ups from 7:00 am to 8:15 a.m.  
**SAT, SUN, & MON TIMED FINALS (10 & UNDER):** will not begin before 12:30 p.m. with warm-ups beginning no sooner than 11:00 a.m.  
**SAT, SUN, & MON FINALS (11 & OVER):** will begin no sooner than ONE HOUR AFTER the completion of the 10 & Under session. The final's start time will be determined at the daily coaches meeting.

**RULES:** Current USA/Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk of Course. All events for 10 & Under are timed finals. All swimmers ages 10 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours. Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated time line, per the Four Hour Rule, based on swimmer's age and gender. If local conditions warrant it, the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director may require a mandatory scratch down.

- All swimmers must be members of a Nevada team registered with USA Swimming or if unattached, a resident of Nevada.
- **All Swimmers must swim in their actual age group as determined by their age on the first day of the meet.**
- 19 & over swimmers will be allowed to swim prelims if they meet the time standards for 15-18. They cannot swim in finals or score points.
- 11 & up swimmers may compete in the open relays or in relays for their age division but not in both.

**QUALIFYING  
TIMES:**

All swimmers must meet the **published minimum time standards** in short course yards. Entries must be submitted on the enclosed Consolidated Entry Card. Entry forms must be completely filled out including the best **SHORT COURSE** time for each event. ***Entered times must be submitted in YARDS.*** Time Conversions from long course yards will no longer be required. Pacific Swimming's Rules and Regulations specify that when you have achieved a specific class level (for example, "B" or "A" in an event in one course, you are considered to be qualified at that same level in all courses. Accordingly you must always enter a time which maintains the class for which you've qualified in an event.

**DISTANCE  
EVENTS:**

All events for Friday night will be run on two (2) courses and are timed final events. 400 IM will be swum fastest to slowest, no alternating and will remain in separate age groups. The 1650 and 1000 freestyle will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girls and boys. The 1000 Freestyle will be swum at the end of Sunday morning session with the top 8 girls and 8 boys swimming during finals in event order. The 1000 & 1650 will be swum 13-14 and 15 & up together, but scored and awarded separately. Swimmers must provide their own timers and lap counters for the 1650 and 1000.

**BONUS**

**EVENTS:** **Make 1 cut, add 2 Bonus Events where the bonus standard is achieved. Make 2 cuts, add 1 Bonus Event where the bonus standard is achieved. MAKE 3 CUTS OR MORE, NO BONUS.**

- FINALS:** Events for the 11-12 and 13-14 age groups will have A and B finals. Events for the 15 & Over age group will have A, B, and C finals.
- Any swimmer qualifying for a C final, consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said consolation final or final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet.
  - If the failure to compete occurs on the last day that the swimmer is entered in an individual event in the meet, and no other individual event penalty is applicable, the swimmer shall be fined \$25.00. [Exceptions for failure to compete: No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if 1) the referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts proof thereof and 2) it is determined by the referee that the failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

- RELAYS:** **Relays will be deck entered by the announced time on Sat. & Sun. Relay cards will be handed out the morning of the relays.**
- All relay swimmers must be entered in an individual event in the meet or the name of the relay only swimmer must be submitted with the team entries with the participation fee.
  - 11 & Over swimmers may compete in the open relays or in relays for their age division, **BUT NOT BOTH.**

**ENTRY  
LIMIT:**

10 and Under: 4 events per day, 7 maximum for the meet, plus relays.  
11 and Over: 3 events per day, 7 maximum for the meet, plus relays. Each team is limited to 2 scoring relays, per event, to be designated as 'A' and 'B,' on relay card; additional non-scoring relays will be allowed. 19 and older may not participate in scoring relays. **Relays will be deck entered, at the cost of \$12.00 per relay regardless of scoring designation. Relay cards will be handed out the morning of the relays.**

- OFFICIALS:** All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership (USA-S) cards in a visible manner. The meet referee will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to the meet referee. **Please contact the meet director with shirt size information.**

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- The sale and use of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in **all** areas of the meet venue.
- There will be closed areas of the deck. The cooperation of swimmers, their families, and coaches will be appreciated.
- Folding and camp chairs are discouraged due to limited space on the deck. Seating is on a first come first serve basis and reserving seats will be limited to teams' seating. Special bleachers have been constructed for the meet to create as much seating as possible.
- **LARGE COOLERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON BLEACHERS.**

- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all 2007 USA Swimming registered athletes residing in the State of Nevada or representing a team in the State of Nevada. Swimmers must be current members of USA Swimming and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. *Disabled swimmers meeting the eligibility requirements are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming Policy.* Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.

- CHECK-IN:** The meet will be deck seeded. **The first two events of each session will close together thirty (30) minutes before the start of the session. All other events will close thirty (30) minutes prior to the estimated start of the event. The 1000 Freestyle events will close at 10:00am Sunday.** Swimmers who do not check-in will not be allowed to compete in the event.

- FINALS:** *The national championship finals scratch rule will be in effect.* An athlete wishing to scratch from finals must do so within 30 minutes of the announcement of the preliminary results of that event.

- SCRATCHES:** Any swimmer who has checked-in for an individual event and fails to swim that event will be barred from competing in his/her next individual event. The penalty will not apply if the swimmer scratches before the event is seeded or if the Meet Referee accepts proof that the failure was caused by illness, injury, or other circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

**ENTRIES:** **THREE OPTIONS FOR MEET ENTRY**

**Option 1:** Online Meet Entries: Enter at <http://swimconnection.com/pc/meet/cars> to receive immediate confirmation of acceptance via email. The "billing information" email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. No Online entries will be accepted after midnight, October 31, 2007. Online entry requires payment by credit card using our secure site. The cost of using online meet entries is \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total entry fee. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Fees collected by the use of this system are completely voluntary. Online Meet Entry is in no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming.

**Option 2: Team Meet Entries:** If teams wish to do a group entry using Hytek's Team Manager please contact Diana Ballard at [diana@tigersharks.org](mailto:diana@tigersharks.org) to receive the computer file and instructions on entries.

**Option 3: Surface Mail Entries:** Entries must be submitted on the enclosed consolidated entry form. Each entry must be completely filled out with **short course yards times** for the events. Entered times must be submitted in yards. "No time" entries will not be accepted.

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MONDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2007, or HAND DELIVERED by WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 31** to the *Carson Tigershark Team Box, Carson Aquatic Facility, 841 N. Roop Street, Carson City, NV 89702.* (address for hand delivery only)

For confirmation of entry include a self-addressed stamped postcard/envelope. **NO REFUNDS** will be given except for mandatory scratch downs. Relays will be deck entered, at the cost of \$12.00 per relay regardless of scoring designation by the announced time on Saturday and Sunday.

**ENTRY FEES:** **\$5.00** for each individual event, \$12.00 for relay events, plus a \$10.00 participation fee per swimmer. Make checks payable to the **Carson Tigersharks** and mail with entries to:

(8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over)  
**Individual Events:** medals 1<sup>st</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> place, ribbons 10<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> place  
(8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over)  
**Relays:** Medals 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>

**ALL AWARDS MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE MEET. NO AWARDS WILL BE MAILED.**  
**Each team is asked to designate a representative to collect the awards.**

**SCORING:** **Individuals:** 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1  
**Relays:** 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2  
8 & Under swimmers will be scored for High Point within their age group, but will not count towards team points. 19 & up swimmers will not score or receive awards.

**ADMISSION:** Free. A four-day program will be available for a fee.

**SNACK BAR:** A snack bar will be available during the meet

- Pancake breakfast available Sat., Sun. and Mon.
- BBQ grill will be serving chicken sandwiches, hamburgers, and hotdogs.

**HOSPITALITY:** Snacks, lunches, and beverages will be served to all working officials, coaches, and timers.

**TIMERS:** Clubs will be assigned lanes based on the number of swimmers from each club (host club will not be expected to time). Swimmers will need to provide their own timers for the 1000 and 1650 Freestyle events.
